MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Clean surface with a soft grit free cloth, mild soap or detergent solution. Rinse immediately with water and dry promptly. Grease and glazing material should be removed with commercial solvents such as mineral spirits or naphtha. Follow with a normal wash and rinse. Do not use a squeegee or any other solvent. Avoid excessive application of strong solvents. Keep moisture away from exposed edges of the of the glass

Avoid abrasive and high alkaline cleaning agents and implements such as razor blades, putty knives etc., which can scratch the glass surfaces. Benzene, gasoline, acetone, carbon tetrachloride, methyl ethyl ketone and muriatic acid-based materials and solvent should not come in contact with School Guard Glass.

Paint grease and glazing compounds can be removed easily before they dry; rub lightly with naphtha or a solution of 50% isopropyl alcohol and water. Then wash with mild soap and water and dry, as instructed.

COMPATIBLE CLEANING AGENTS

Joy, Palmolive, Naphtha VM&P Grade, Isopropyl Alcohol. (Avoid products containing ammonia).
