Field Trimming Mortised Bottom

Field Trimming

The standard mortised bottom on the AF-100 door series is designed to be field trimmed to accommodate floor condition without compromising the doors core. The maximum recommended amount that can be removed is 1 1/8".

If you have an opening that requires door bottom trimming;

- 1. Determine the amount that needs to be removed. 1 1/8" MAXIMUM
- 2. If the door is painted, take precautions to protect the finish
- 3. Lay the door on sawhorses and mark a cut line
- 4. Clamp straight edge in place for a saw guide
- 5. Make cut using a 1/8"x 7 ¼" masonry circular saw blade. High-speed steel and carbide tipped not recommended
- 6. Factory painted doors are supplied with touch up kits. Touch up as necessary
- 7. Rehang door and check clearance

Recommended Auto Door Bottom Mechanisms
