Omega Aluminum Frames is proud to say that since 2005 we have been committed to the LEED Process and Going Green is not an option but is a culture that we are committed to.

Omega is able to help you with your LEED requirements and can help you certify your project for LEED 2.2 Certification. Omega currently recycles 100% of any scrap material that is generated through our fabrication process. The "Billet" used by Omega's Extrusion Vendor utilizes 78% recycled Billet and 22% Prime Billet.
